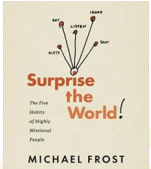

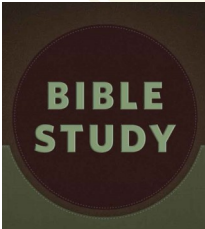

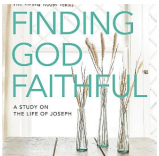

Kids, come enjoy an evening of fun activities while parents are in their classes.

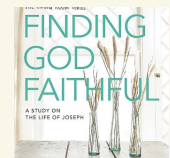
